

HOW ANONYMOUS REPORTING WORKS

1

YOU NOTICE A CONCERN

You see or experience something that doesn't feel right, such as someone being bullied, a threat posted online, or you feel unsafe.

2

YOU REPORT IT ANONYMOUSLY

You share what happened using the STOPit website or app. Include what you saw, when it happened, and who was involved and any other relevant information.

3

THE SCHOOL SAFETY TEAM REVIEWS THE REPORT

School staff trained to handle safety concerns read your report. They make sure no personal information about you is shared and determine the urgency of the situation.

4

AN INVESTIGATION BEGINS

The report is sent to people who can help address the concern. They gather information and talk to students or staff involved. They will not discuss the reporting student.

5

THE CONVERSATION MAY CONTINUE

As the investigation continues, you may be asked questions through the STOPit platform for more details in order to address the issue in the best way.

6

THE CONCERN IS RESOLVED

The school takes steps to fix the issue and keep everyone safe. Actions might include talking to students involved, offering support, or changing school procedures.
