Questions – ask everyone:

1. Have you traveled outside of Arkansas in the last 14 days? If yes:
 - a. Was that travel outside of the United States?
 - b. Was that travel to any of these states: Washington, California, Louisiana, New York, New Jersey or Connecticut?
2. In the last 14 days, have you been in direct contact with someone who is confirmed to have COVID 19?
3. Do you have any of the following symptoms:
 - Shortness of breath
 - Cough
 - Sore throat
 - Fever in last 24 hours

Take the person’s temperature.

Screening Outcome ↓	
Traveled outside the US in last 14 days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can’t work • Give employee a mask • Send home • Quarantine for 14 days, contact supervisor and Employee Health • Give “Instructions for UAMS Employees” handout
Traveled to one of the 6 high risk states AND has either direct contact with a confirm COVID-19 patient or has fever or respiratory symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can’t work • Give employee a mask • Send home • Quarantine for 14 days, contact supervisor and Employee Health • Give “Instructions for UAMS Employees” handout
Traveled to one of the 6 high risk states AND has NOT HAD direct contact with a confirm COVID-19 patient or have fever or respiratory symptoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give sticker • Give “Instructions for UAMS Employees” handout and instruct them to complete the SEHS survey • OK to go to work.
No to Travel Questions but had Direct contact with confirmed COVID-19 patient within the last 14 days	<p>If used proper PPE, see temperature and symptom guidance below to determine if employee is able to go to work.</p>
	<p>If didn’t use proper PPE,</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can’t work • Give employee a mask • Send home • Quarantine for 14 days, contact supervisor and Employee Health • Give “Instructions for UAMS Employees” handout
No to Travel Questions but has a Temperature >100.4 degrees or fever in last 24 hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can’t work • Give employee a mask • Send home • Contact supervisor and Employee Health • Give “Instructions for UAMS Employees” handout
No to Travel Questions but has a Temperature < 100.4 degrees And respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give employee a mask • May go to work, but must wear mask entire shift • If fever develops, go home and call Employee Health

No to Travel Questions and

Temperature is
< 100.4 degrees and has no respiratory
symptoms

- Give sticker
- OK to go to work.
