Dear Members of the Arkansas Trauma System Rehabilitation Sub-Committee:

Since our October report, the activities of the TBI State Partnership Program, UAMS Trauma Rehabilitation Resources Program (TRRP), and the TBI Advisory Board Workgroup include the following accomplishments:

- The TBI SPP held a TBI Advisory Board Workgroup meeting on January 26, 2021. Participants in the workgroup discussed the state plan, updates, status of the workgroup, and how to actively engage with stakeholders. Guest speakers included Pam Hall (Experience with Waiver Programs); NeCol Whitehead (Support Groups); and Kimberly Wells (TBI in the Incarcerated Juvenile Population). The workgroup will meet again on April 27, 2021. Meetings are open to the public and information is available on the TBI SPP website.
- On December 18, 2020, the TBI SPP team presented a national webinar for the Administration for Community Living on the topic of healthcare during the COVID-19 pandemic. Vida Tolerson, wife of Alex Tolerson, person living with brain injury, shared her story. Alex sustained a TBI at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. The event had approximately 265 attendees.
- On November 11, 2020, Amy Goddard (Arkansas Department of Education), Bethany Baldwin (ICAN), and Steven Long (ICAN) presented information on assistive technology for the TBI community. Amy and Steven are participants on the Advisory Board Workgroup. The presentation will be available soon on the LearnOnDemand.org education portal. Continuing education will be available.
- The winter issue of the Brain Waves Newsletter features the story of Lauralee Bardwell. The newsletter was delivered to the TBI community in paper and digital formats.
- Online support groups are now available for those living with TBI and caregivers. The
  groups are a collaboration between Sources for Community Independent Living in
  Fayetteville and the Trauma Rehabilitation Resources Program. Jim Mather, executive
  director of Sources, is a participant on the TBI Advisory Board Workgroup.
- The TBI SPP team continues to participate and contribute in three Administration for Community Living (ACL) national workgroups – Advisory Boards, Trust Funds, Underserved Populations.
- The TRRP resource website continues to be updated with COVID-19 resources, and the team continues to facilitate telemedicine consultations.
